If a person with a visual impairment who needs assistance to evacuate the building in an emergency will be working alone or in isolation, they must notify a member(s) of staff prior to starting. For regular activities, an 'Evacuation Buddy' should be arranged to help guide you out of the building.

Alarm sounds.					
<ul> <li>Passenger lifts <u>MUST NOT</u> be used during a fire emergency evacuation.</li> </ul>					
<ul> <li>Notify your pre-arranged 'Evacuation Buddy'/Tutor/Colleagues/Fire Marshal that you will need assistance to evacuate the building.</li> </ul>					
<ul> <li>With assistance, proceed to the nearest stairwell indicated by the green directional fire exit signs.</li> </ul>					
If further assistance is required, there are refuge communication systems located in all stairwells above ground level (except for Kirkham) in all academic buildings across campus.					
<ul> <li>The refuge communication system will allow for communication to be made to personnel on the ground floor who can arrange for assistance.</li> </ul>					
<ul> <li>Once assistance has arrived, they will help guide the way down the stairs in order to evacuate the building and to a place of safety.</li> </ul>					
<ul> <li>Persons should wait at the place of safety and NOT re-enter the building until told otherwise by University personnel.</li> </ul>
